WHAT HAVE WE ACCOMPLISHED?



- Strengthen our Basic Needs Program that helps victims with their immediate, emergency needs. We are seeking partnerships to receive donated toiletries and funding to distribute meals during outreach.
- Create a Safe-House Program by identifying partners from hotels, shelters, and other places of refuge that can temporarily house victims while we work on our own Safe House.
- Expand our Recognize and Report Program to train law enforcement, residents, teachers, and counselors to recognize and report the signs of human trafficking.
- Develop Relationships with Government by sharing our experiences of working with trafficking victims and assisting legislators improving government policies addressing human trafficking.
