These goodies were distributed throughout the city and surrounding areas to the women and girls we usually serve, as well as homeless shelters, rehabilitation facilities, at-risk youth centers, police officers, sober living homes, and many ordinary people who others wanted to spread some love to in this difficult time.

Our goal is to help women and girls find their intrinsic worth and discover their true potential. On February 11th, we hosted a virtual event entitled "Woman Health Thyself", with partners Niema Golphin and Amanda Paul to discuss what it takes for a woman to heal.

Along with our founder **Sakinah Love**, these ladies spoke on of **holistic healing** including **trauma work**, **inner-child healing**, **meditation practice and benefits**, **self-care and self-love**, **shadow-work**, **and forgiveness**.

CONTINUING TO EDUCATE

On February 9th, Redeemed For A Cause Outreach held a training for the Philadelphia Assistant District Attorney's office (ADA). Our founder Sakinah Love presented a PowerPoint that contained information regarding the Intersection of Human Trafficking and Domestic Violence. Due to the positive feedback from PowerPoint presentation, the ADAs now feel like they can tackle the human trafficking cases.

On February 5th and February 26th, Redeemed For A Cause Outreach held a 2-part Human Trafficking 101 virtual training with Richard Allen Preparatory Charter School where we educated the school administration about the risks, barriers, and signs of human trafficking. Also, we opened a toiletry closet at Richard Allen Preparatory Charter School where the students will have access to basic hygiene needs.

We greatly value these partnerships within our community. We always leap on the change to help educate others, including those in law enforcement, on the hidden crime that is human trafficking and help dispel any misconceptions. These events received great feedback and we hope to hold more in the future, as the advocacy never stops!

TOILETRY DRIVE

Redeemed for a Cause is hosting an ongoing critical toiletry drive to address needs created by the pandemic. CoVid-19 has worsened sex trafficking in Philadelphia, in particular child sex trafficking, and our women and girls are in need of:

- underwear
- tank tops
- · socks
- · disposable washcloths
- deodorant (travel size)
- · hand sanitizer (travel size)
- make-up pouches
- ziploc bags
- tampons
- · pads

- · lotion (travel size)
- combs
- brushes
- · toothbrush/toothpaste (travel size)
- shampoo (travel size)
 conditioner (travel size)
- razor
- · bars of soap
- · make-up

Drop off toiletries at our drop-in center, 730 - 732 W Moyamensing Avenue, between 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. on Monday, Friday, or Saturday. Monetary donations are welcome in place of toiletries.

\$25 provides a woman or girl trapped in sexual exploitation with hygiene essentials and a snack for a month

\$50 covers the weekly cost of gas for our van to pick up donations and transport women to medical appointments and our drop-in center

\$75 provides crisis support to meet urgent needs of women during our BI-WEEKLY outreach efforts

\$100 helps to cover the monthly rent for our drop-in center and provides day-to-day operation support







Many have inquired with RFACO asking how they could support our efforts to provide for trafficked women and girls, even after our Sound the Alarm initiative has ended. Well, here's a way!

We are seeking help to maintain the upkeep of the toiletries we give out during our street outreach as well providing them to students in elementary and high schools. Schools we work with include West Catholic Preparatory High School, Richard Allen Preparatory High School, and Roxborough High School.
