This month we held our annual Spring Toiletry Drive "grab & go" addition with a sandwich lunch distribution. This event was a massive success, and we were able to give out over **50 lunches**, as well as provide toiletry kits to everyone who came by the event! The kits included necessities such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, menstrual supplies, deodorant, shampoo, underwear, and combs/brushes.

Additionally, we were able to fill many boxes for the continuing toiletry closets we provide for schools in the Philadelphia and Baltimore areas. The schools we partner with include Roxborough High School, West Catholic Preparatory High School, Richard Allen Charter School, and Morgan State University.
