NEW PARTNERSHIPS

During the month of June, we focused on partnering with organizations such as **Salvation Army New Day Drop-In Center, WOAR, Vaux Big Picture High School,** and **Richard Allen Preparatory Charter School.**

Salvation Army New Day Drop-In Center, we are joining them with the roll calls at the police departments starting in July. Also, we will have joint outreach on weekdays with the Salvation Army starting in July where we will distribute care packages, service flyers, and bad date sheets. During the roll calls, we can inform the police officers on areas with an increase of human trafficking, new tactics being used, how to identify human trafficking victims, etc.

WOAR, we are collaborating with them by providing pointers which include resources for the women and community as they open their first drop-in center.

Vaux Big Picture High School, we are partnering with them by opening a toiletry closet for the students to have access to basic hygiene products.

Richard Allen Preparatory Charter School, we are partnering with them to run **groups** with the students starting in July as well as continuing to **operate the toiletry closet.**

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

As we prepare for our joint outreach with Salvation Army New Day Drop-In Center in July, we are partnering with the local community such as restaurants, funeral homes, schools, churches, etc. to become **Community HUBs**. In the local businesses, we will provide **containers of care packages, service flyers, and bad date sheets** to distribute to the ladies in the community. The community HUBS will be located in West Philadelphia, South Philadelphia, North Philadelphia, Center City, etc.

OPENING OF THE TEEN HUB

Over the month of June, the members from the Block Church helped to transform our South Philadelphia Drop-In Center into a Teen HUB. Starting in July, we will start running groups with the teens where we will discuss issues such as consent, healthy relationships, self-love, etc. These groups will give insight to the teens so that they can learn how to create boundaries, be aware how they perceive themselves, identifying their self-worth, etc. Also, we want to create a safe space for our teens to encourage them, support them, and hear them.

Many have inquired with Redeemed for a Cause Outreach asking how they could support our ongoing efforts to provide basic necessities for trafficked women and girls. Well here is a way!

We are seeking help to maintain the upkeep of the toiletries we give out during our street outreach as well providing them to students in elementary and high schools. Schools we work with include West Catholic Preparatory High School, Richard Allen Preparatory Charter School, Roxborough High School, and starting in July Vaux Big Picture High School.

Redeemed for a Cause is hosting an ongoing critical toiletry drive to address needs created by the pandemic. CoVid-19 has worsened sex trafficking in Philadelphia, in particular child sex trafficking, and our women and girls are in need of:

- underwear
- · tank tops
- · socks
- disposable washcloths
- · deodorant (travel size)
- · hand sanitizer (travel size)
- · make-up pouches
- · ziploc bags
- tampons
- · pads

- · lotion (travel size)
- combs
- brushes
- toothbrush/toothpaste (travel size)
- shampoo (travel size)
- · conditioner (travel size)
- razor
- · bars of soap
- · make-up

Drop off toiletries at our drop-in center, 730 - 732 W Moyamensing Avenue, between 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. on Monday, Friday, or Saturday. Monetary donations are welcome in place of toiletries.

\$25 provides a woman or girl trapped in sexual exploitation with hygiene essentials and a snack for a month

\$50 covers the weekly cost of gas for our van to pick up donations and transport women to medical appointments and our drop-in center

\$75 provides crisis support to meet urgent needs of women during our BI-WEEKLY outreach efforts

\$100 helps to cover the monthly rent for our drop-in center and provides day-to-day operation support
